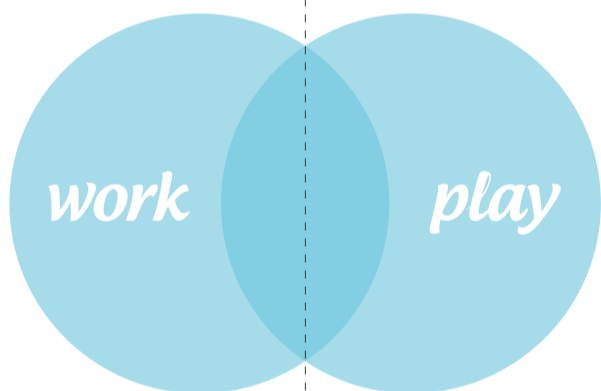

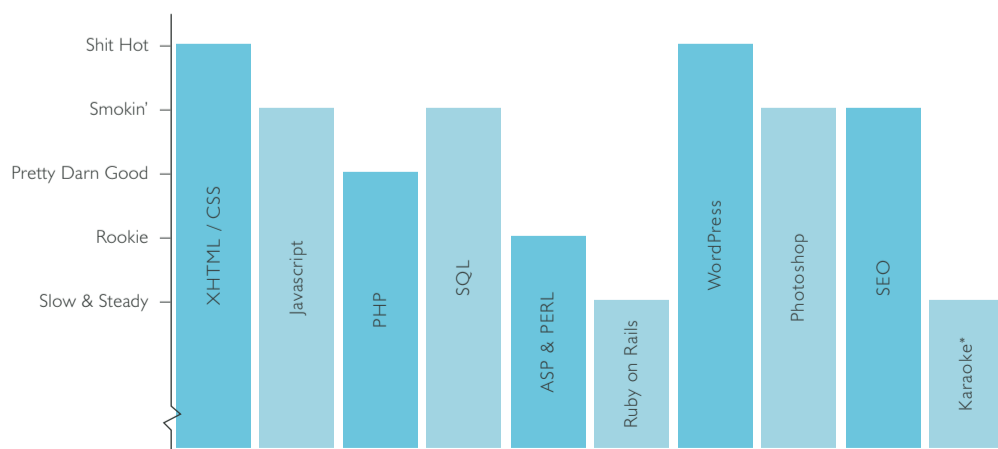

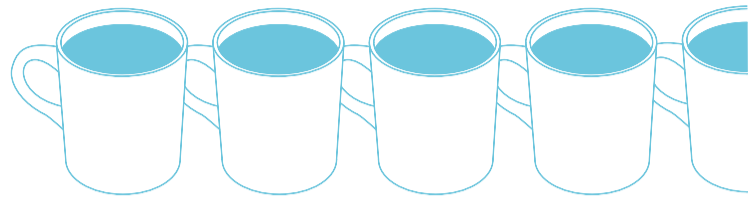

Reporting directly to the IT Manager, I was responsible for providing IT support to internal Lancaster University departments. I was also tasked with creating and maintaining many intranet and internet web applications in line with the University's Internet strategies. Major achievements include the development and implementation of a web-based student card registration system. In its first 7 days of operation, the system successfully recorded information relating to over 10,000 students, allowing them access to online services. Working within a larger team of software developers, I also created a SQL-backed management system for the student housing department.

JANUARY 2006 - APRIL 2006

Freelance - **Web Developer**

During this period I temporarily became self-employed and undertook contract work for LA Serve, a design and marketing agency near Lancaster. This supported and funded my move to Bristol where I commenced full time employment with a publishing company (Merricks Media). During my time working for LAServe, I was engaged in developing a number of PHP/MySQL sites.

APRIL 2006 - JUNE 2008

Merricks Media, Bath, UK - **Web Developer / IT Administrator**

Over two years working for Merricks Media, my main role was focussed on implementing the company's Internet strategy. This was focussed on evolving the company from a print-based publisher operating in the overseas property and travel sector, into an online publisher. During my time I redeveloped and maintained the company's core websites, modernising their Internet offering and providing data capture functionality. Supporting new magazine launches required effective planning to ensure deadlines were achieved. My role required working closely with an external organisation to develop their large property and travel portal website on the MySource Matrix platform. I subsequently trained editorial staff in the use of this platform.

JUNE 2008 - SEPTEMBER 2009

Socket Creative, Bath UK - **Web Developer**

Socket Creative is a start-up Internet publisher. At Socket, I am involved in the specification, development and maintenance of a number of editorially driven websites working alongside graphic designers and writers. I have delivered excellent quality products both internally and for external clients using a number of CMS platforms. As the only developer in the company, I am responsible for the complete delivery of all websites and also the management of two dedicated servers, domain names, DNS and email.

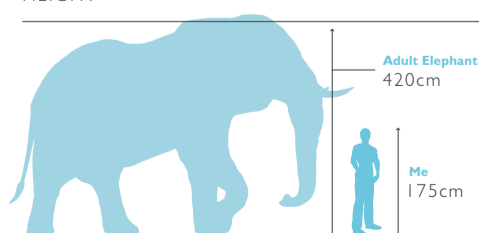
